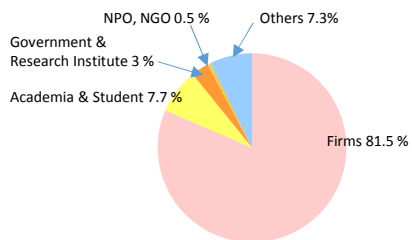

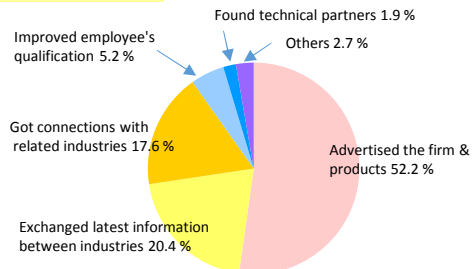

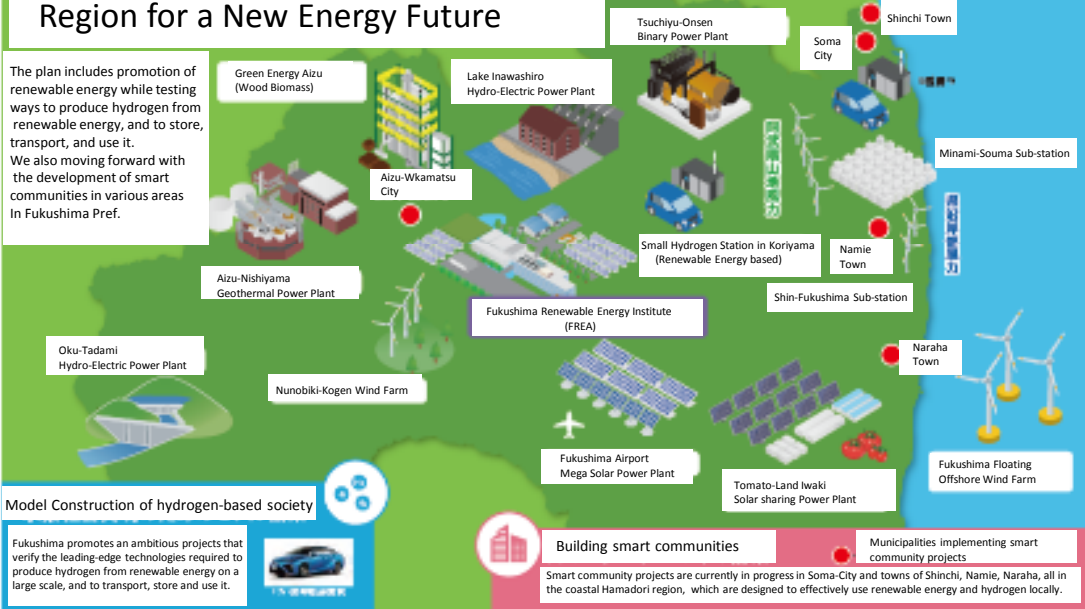

Municipalities implementing smart community projects
Smart community projects are currently in progress in Soma-City and towns of Shinchi, Namie, Naraha, all in the coastal Hamadori region, which are designed to effectively use renewable energy and hydrogen locally.

- *One booth will be provided for free to the government, local public agencies and research institutions including universities/colleges. But there is a limit to the number of the free booths.

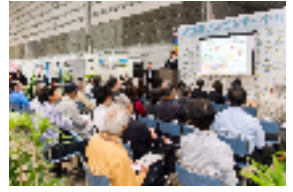

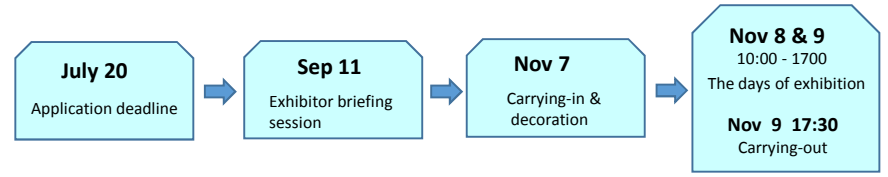
Application Deadline

If the number of applications has reached the planned number, no further applications will be accepted even if it is received before the deadline. The deadline may be extended when there are still vacancies.

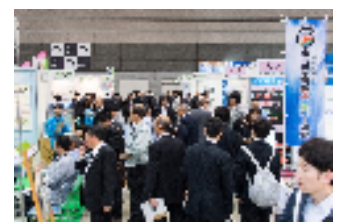
Process & Schedule

Promotional activities

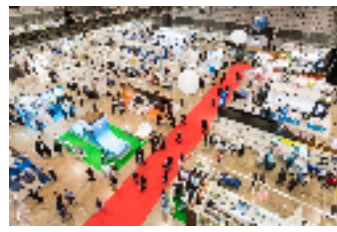
- Provide exhibitors with posters, flyers and other exhibition materials for free of charge.

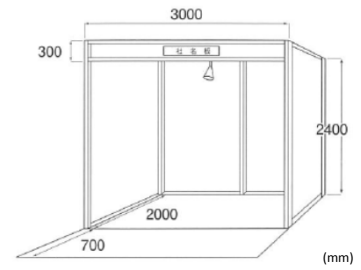

●How to Apply

After filling in necessary information on the previous page, please send us via email. We will reply after we received it. Please contact us if there is no reply within one week.

●Application Deadline

Thursday, July 20, 2017

Please note that if the number of applications has reached the planned number, no further applications will be accepted even if it is received before the deadline.

In the meantime the deadline may be extended if there are still vacancies. Please contact us for details.

●Decision of exhibitors and payment

Upon receiving the application form, we will review them and decide the exhibitors. Based on that decision, we issue an invoice for the exhibition fee. You are requested to pay your exhibition fee in full by the date we announce. You shall be liable for the relevant bank fees.

The exhibition contract shall be concluded when the invoice is issued.

●Cancellation

Exhibition fee will not be refunded if an exhibitor cancels an application for any reason.

●Booth Allotment

The Organizer will allot the booths through taking into account the contents and exhibitor's industry fields, as well as venue structure.

●Change in exhibition period and cancellation of the exhibition

The organizer may be forced to vary the exhibition period or cancel the exhibition due to the causes beyond its control such as natural disaster, force majeure, etc.

The organizer shall not be responsible for any damages inflicted on the exhibitors due to the change in the exhibition period or cancellation of the exhibition.

If the exhibition is cancelled before the date of the exhibition, the organizer will reimburse part or all of the exhibition fee.

●Other

•Joint Exhibition

In case of joint application where two or more applicants wish to exhibit in the same booth, one representative applicant shall be selected.

The representative applicant shall be responsible for fulfilling the application procedures and informing the organizer of the name(s) of co-exhibitor(s). The organizer shall contact the representative applicant only.

•Prohibitions on allocated space

The Exhibitor/Approved Applicant shall not sell, buy, mortgage, transfer all or part of the allocated space to a third party. The Exhibitor/Approved Applicant shall not exchange the allocated space with another Exhibitor/Approved Applicant.
